## The Perlman Music Program *Summer Music School* SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

*We recommend that you print your first and last name on each item you bring.*

### DAILY CAMP CLOTHING

- Day to day camp attire should be casual and comfortable. Shorts, t-shirts, sandals, are encouraged.
- Good sneakers are recommended for recreational activities.
- Swimwear (including old sneakers or water shoes) is encouraged for use on PMP's private beach.
- Sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets are required as evenings can get chilly.
- Please bring a raincoat and umbrella for rainy days.
- If you wear glasses: **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO BRING TWO PAIRS**

### CONCERT CLOTHING

- Students must wear all white for orchestra and chorus concerts. *Beige, tan, etc. will not be accepted.*
- Boys: White shirt, white slacks or white jeans (no holes), dress shoes
- Girls: White blouses and skirts, white slacks or white jeans (no holes), white dress
- Shoes do not have to be white, but should be clean, neat, and comfortable.
- Each chamber music group decides as a group what they will wear for performances. It is a good idea to bring a dark suit (if you have one) and tie. At the very least, you should DEFINITELY bring a black dress shirt and pants.
- *Works in Progress* concert (these are the concerts when you will perform your solos, sonatas, and concertos) dress is up to each performer. Most students wear dark pants and dress shirts or suits or colorful blouses/skirts or dresses. You should bring what you would normally feel comfortable wearing for a solo recital performance.

### LINENS

***PMP can only supply linens for students traveling from abroad.***

***All domestic students should bring:***

- blankets or sleeping bag, sheets (2)

- pillowcases (2), towels (4)
- beach towel

## **LAUNDRY**

All students are responsible for their own laundry. The PMP laundry room provides free washer/dryer use, as well as detergent. Fellows are available, should students need assistance.

## **MUSICAL SUPPLIES**

- Bows should be re-haired immediately before camp. **DO NOT** arrive at camp in need of a re-hair. PMP cannot promise that this service will be provided while you are on Shelter Island.
- Wire Music Stand (**REQUIRED!**)
- Solo Music (violinists: please bring a photo copy of your pieces)
- Chamber Music Parts and score (assignments will be sent out prior to arriving at camp)
- Extra set of strings
- Mutes
- Back up bow (if you have one)
- Metronome
- Watch or small alarm clock for your practice room (Do not rely on your cell phone, as PMP has a “no cell phone in the practice room” rule.)

## **RECREATION**

- Frisbees, soccer balls, tennis rackets, running shoes and clothes, bathing suits, decks of cards, board games, etc are all welcome. The camp provides many of these items, but if you would like to bring your own, you can do so. You may also want to bring iPods, CD's, etc for listening to music.

## **INTERNET**

- Computers with internet access for email are provided in each dorm.

## **OTHER**

- Plastic water bottle – water coolers are located throughout campus, but water bottles are recommended for environmental purposes
